See, Hear, Understand, Believe...Convert!

15 *And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.*

19 *Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord.*

Hear The Gospel of Christ, then Believe

Romans 10:14-17
King James Version

14 *How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?*

15 *And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!*

16 *But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias (Isaiah) saith, Lord, who hath believed our report?*

17 *So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.*

The Gospel of Christ

1 Corinthians 15:1-4
King James Version

15 *Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;*

2 *By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.*

3 *For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;*

4 *And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:*

Summary of the Gospel of Christ

1. Christ died.
2. For our sins.
3. Was buried.
4. Rose again.
5. According to the Scriptures.

When you trust and believe in the Gospel of Christ, you are saved.

The importance of the blood of Christ for Salvation

Hebrews 9:22
King James Version

22 *And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.*

*Remission in this context is referring to the remission (forgiveness) of sins. There is no remission of your sins without the shed blood of Jesus Christ.

Why do you need the remission of your sins through the blood atonement of Jesus Christ?

Hebrews 9:27-28
King James Version

*27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
28 So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.*

*Everyone is going to a judgment at the end of their lives.

Romans 3:23
King James Version

23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

*Nobody is good enough to get to Heaven, the Lord's Kingdom, through their own good works. It is only through the finished work of Jesus Christ's blood atonement for our sins on the Cross that we receive His gift of eternal salvation. This should come as a relief for anyone who thinks they have to earn their way into Heaven!

The only way you get to Heaven is through accepting Jesus Christ's free gift of eternal salvation, simply by believing, trusting, placing your faith in His finished work on the Cross for you. It is not by anything you do; it's by simply placing your faith/trust in what *He did for you*, that gives you eternal salvation. You are set free through Jesus Christ!

Faith- not in men, but in the Power of God
1 Corinthians 2:2
King James Version

2 For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified.

*These are the Apostle Paul's words speaking about eternal salvation. He is not claiming to be knowledgeable about anything except Jesus Christ's crucifixion, His blood atonement sacrifice for our sins.

Danger of denying the importance of Jesus Christ's blood atonement for our sins
Hebrews 10:29
King James Version

29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?

Jesus Christ's shed blood as the only atonement that could save you of your sins and offer you the promise of eternal salvation

Hebrews 9:11-15

King James Version

11 But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building;

12 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

13 For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:

14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

15 And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

We Rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ being justified by His blood!

Romans 5:8-11

King James Version

8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

10 For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.

11 And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement.

How do you become saved?

Acts 16:30-31

King James Version

30 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved?

31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

**What happens once you believe on the Lord Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior?
Trusting in His blood atonement on the Cross for your sins?**

Ephesians 1:13-14

King James Version

13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,

14 Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.

*The moment you believe, trust, have faith in Jesus Christ's blood atonement for your sins on the Cross based on the Gospel of Christ (1 Corinthians 15:1-4), you are eternally sealed with the Holy Spirit of God until the day of redemption, which is either the day you die, or, if the Rapture happens when you are alive, you are taken up to Heaven in the "twinkling of an eye!" (see 1 Corinthians 15:52.)

What must your faith be in to get saved?
-The blood atonement of Jesus Christ for your sins
Romans 3:24-25
King James Version

24 *Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:
25 Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;*

Justified by Faith, not works!
It is not what you do- it is what Jesus did!
You are not justified by your righteousness, only justified by Jesus' righteousness

Romans 4:1-5
King James Version

4 *What shall we say then that Abraham our father, as pertaining to the flesh, hath found?
2 For if Abraham were justified by works, he hath whereof to glory; but not before God.
3 For what saith the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.
4 Now to him that worketh is the reward not reckoned of grace, but of debt.
5 But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.*

Justified by Faith
Galatians 3:22-25
King James Version

22 *But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe.
23 But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed.
24 Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.
25 But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster.*

Saved by Grace through Faith

Ephesians 2:8-9

King James Version

8 *For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:*

9 *Not of works, lest any man should boast.*

Believing unto Salvation

Hebrews 10:39

King James Version

39 *But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul.*

Without Faith it is impossible to please God!

Hebrews 11:6-7

King James Version

6 *But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.*

7 *By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.*

I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ!

Romans 1:16

King James Version

16 *For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek (Gentile).*

Are you saved?

1 Timothy 4:10

King James Version

10 *For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Saviour of all men, specially of those that believe.*

Shining the Light of the Gospel of Christ

2 Corinthians 4:3-6

King James Version

3 *But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost:*

4 *In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.*

5 *For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake.*

6 *For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.*

Why should you take the opportunity as soon as you read and hear this message of the Gospel of Christ to get saved?

***Because you are going to an eternal judgment by God the moment you die.**

Hebrews 9:27

King James Version

27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

Deuteronomy 30:19

King James Version

19 *I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:*

Why has God determined a judgment on everyone if He is truly a loving God?

Psalms 89:14

King James Version

14 *Justice and judgment are the habitation of thy throne:
mercy and truth shall go before thy face.*

Justice and judgment establish God's Throne!

Does God hate mankind since He has determined a judgment on all men at the end of their lives?

No! God, loves all men, every being!

John 3:16
King James Version

16 *For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.*

God gave His only son, Jesus Christ, as a sacrifice in persecution and His crucifixion on the Cross, His blood atonement offering for our sins so that when we face our eternal judgment, we are forgiven of our sins, if we believed and received the gift of eternal salvation paid for by Jesus Christ.

How do we believe and receive His gift of eternal salvation? By believing in the Gospel of Christ (1 Corinthians 15:1-4) that Christ died as a blood atonement sacrifice for our sins and was risen from the grave 3 days later into Heaven.

God has not appointed us to His wrath, but to obtain salvation through Jesus Christ...

1 Thessalonians 5:9
King James Version

9 *For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,*

God can't break His own laws of justice and judgment that establishes His throne. This is why everyone has to go to the judgment. He gave us a way out though! Through the perfect sacrifice of His only Son, Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ is our Lord and Savior; if we only choose Him! If we choose to believe in Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior, we will be forgiven of all of our sins at this eternal judgment.

What happens at this eternal judgment?

You will go to one of two judgments based on whether you chose to receive Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior according to the Gospel of Christ: 1 Corinthians 15:1-4.

If you chose to believe in Him and His blood atonement for your sins, by faith, and received Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, you will go to the Judgment Seat of Christ:

The Judgment Seat of Christ
2 Corinthians 5:10
King James Version

10 *For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.*

(The Judgment Seat of Christ is addressing believers who chose Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. All believers' sins will be forgiven, and rewards will be awarded at this Judgment.)

What is the penalty of your sins if you reject Jesus Christ's gift of eternal salvation?

Romans 6:23 King James Version

23 *For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.*

- Death, in this context is eternal.
- We are all sinners and subject to eternal death without Jesus Christ.
- Nobody is good enough to get to Heaven on their own. (Isaiah 64:6)
- Eternal death is eternal separation from God.
- Eternal death is damnation in a lake of fire.
- Alone, in complete darkness.
- Forever-with no possibility of ever returning.
- No second chance!

How can you escape this eternal lake of fire for your sins at that judgment?

-The second half of Romans 6:23 tells us, "but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

-Simply believe, have faith, trust in the finished work of Jesus Christ's blood atonement on the Cross for all of your sins. (See the Gospel of Christ: **1 Corinthians 15:1-4 KJV**)

Who is Jesus Christ?

Jesus Christ is the Son of man, He is the Son of God of the Divine Trinity: The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The three are one and the only divinity; the creator of all things, the universe. The first and last. The Alpha and the Omega!

Matthew 28:19 King James Version

19 *Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost (Spirit):*

Why is He called the Son of man?

God, the Father, sent His only Son, Jesus Christ, as a perfect sacrifice, to shed His blood for the sins of man. All who believe and trust in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior, His blood atonement for their sins, will gain everlasting life, eternal salvation.

John 3:16 King James Version

16 *For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.*

Why would a perfect God, who created the entire universe, take human form and let people crucify Him and shed His blood on a Cross?

Because He loves every single person that much. Without His persecution and perfect blood atonement sacrifice for our sins on the Cross, there would be no other way for anyone to be saved of their sins and gain entrance into His Heavenly Kingdom. We would all be condemned to Hell, the lake of fire for eternity, without His sacrifice.

Why would anyone *reject* His sacrifice for our sins and condemn themselves to the lake of fire for eternity?

They choose/chose not to believe.

Gaining eternal salvation into Heaven simply by believing/trusting in Jesus Christ's blood atonement on the Cross for us sounds too easy. There's nothing else we need to do except believe and trust in His sacrifice for our sins?

**Romans 10:9-13
King James Version**

9 *That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.*

10 *For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.*

11 *For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.*

12 *For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him.*

13 *For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.*

That's correct. It is easy- almost too easy! Yet there are many who simply reject Jesus Christ's gift of eternal salvation through His blood atonement on the Cross to save us of our sins.

**Matthew 7:13-14
King James Version**

13 *Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:*

14 *Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.*

What is the *narrow way* which leads unto life?

**John 14:6
King James Version**

6 *Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.*

Jesus Christ is the only way to eternal life in Heaven. There is nothing *you* can do to save yourself, which should come as a relief! Jesus Christ has already paid the price for you!

There are no works you can do, not one, that are counted towards your eternal salvation, other than believing in/placing your trust in the finished work of Jesus Christ on the Cross, His blood atonement for your sins.

You should do good works regardless, *because* you are saved, and following the example of Jesus Christ, but not *to* get saved. All of your good works will count here and towards your rewards in Heaven, they are not forgotten. Only your sins will be forgotten, forgiven, when you place your faith/trust/believe/receive Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior.

When do you *know* you are saved?

The moment you believe, place your trust in, have faith in Jesus Christ's blood atonement sacrifice on the Cross for your sins.

Ephesians 1:13-14 King James Version

*13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,
14 Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.*

*The moment you believe in Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, you are His purchased possession! You are sealed with His Holy Spirit, an heir in His family, His Kingdom. The day of redemption is the day you die or the day you are taken alive in the Rapture if that happens while you are alive, you are going to Heaven for eternity!

2 Corinthians 5:17-21 King James Version

*17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
18 And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;
19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.
20 Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.
21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.*

*You are a new creature once you believe and receive Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior! You receive His Holy Spirit sealed within you the moment you trust on Him as your Lord and Savior. You are reconciled to God through Jesus Christ. You are forgiven of your sins! You are now an ambassador for Christ. The righteousness of Jesus Christ is counted on your behalf, by God.

As Christians, we should pursue the example set by Jesus Christ.
You are to walk in the Spirit and not the flesh.

The Fruits of the Spirit
Galatians 5:22-26
King James Version

- 22** *But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,*
23 *Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.*
24 *And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.*
25 *If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.*
26 *Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.*

What about sin after conversion to Christianity?

You are still eternally saved, but you should confess and repent of your sins.

1 John 1:9
King James Version

9 *If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins,
and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.*

Revelation 3:19
King James Version

19 *As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.*

What is “the Gospel of your Salvation,” referenced in Ephesians 1:13-14 KJV?

The Gospel of your Salvation- the Gospel of Christ, is:

1 Corinthians 15:1-4 KJV

- 1** *Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;*
2 *By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.*
3 *For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;*
4 *And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:*

What does 1 Corinthians 15:1-4 (The Gospel of Christ) mean?

1. Jesus Christ died on the Cross 2000 years ago (around 33 AD), as a blood propitiation for your sins.
2. He was buried.
3. He rose again the third day into Heaven according to to the Scriptures (the Bible).

*The moment you place your faith, trust, believe in the Gospel of Christ: 1 Corinthians 15:1-4, you receive His gift of eternal salvation for you through His blood atonement on the Cross, you are saved. You are sealed into His Kingdom!

What if you have doubts about your salvation?

Did you believe, receive, place your trust in, have faith in the Gospel of Christ in **1 Corinthians 15:1-4 KJV?**

If that answer is yes, you are/were saved- eternally sealed into His Heavenly Kingdom- the moment you placed your faith, trust, in Him as your Lord and Savior. You have to simply trust God's word in the Bible.

Ephesians 1:13-14 King James Version

13 *In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,*

14 *Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.*

*You are a purchased possession by Jesus Christ! The moment you receive Him as your Lord and Savior trusting, believing, placing your faith in the Gospel of Christ, you are sealed into His Kingdom for Eternity!

The reality is, there is a Heaven and a Hell.

Heaven is absolute perfection and it is never-ending. You are always in the presence of God, never separated. Perfect rest, perfect peace, harmony, contentment, fulfillment, no sickness, no disease, no sadness, no pain, no suffering, no death, ever again. Heaven is greater than you could ever dream or imagine, and it will last forever.

A Mansion Reserved for You in Heaven

John 14:2
King James Version

2 *In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.*

"Treasures in Heaven"
Matthew 6:20
King James Version

20 *But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:*

“No more tears, no more death, neither sorrow, crying, or pain”

Revelation 21:4

King James Version

4 *And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.*

God has great things prepared for them that love Him!

1 Corinthians 2:9

9 *But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.*

Perpetual Rest for Believers in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior

Hebrews 4:9-11

King James Version

9 *There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God.*

10 *For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from his.*

11 *Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.*

Matthew 11:28-29

King James Version

28 *Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.*

29 *Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.*

“The Thief on the Cross who asked Jesus to remember him”

Luke 23:42-43

42 *And he said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom.*

43 *And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, Today shalt thou be with me in paradise.*

A Glimpse into Heaven

Revelation 22:1-5

2 *In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.*

3 *And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him:*

4 *And they shall see his face; and his name shall be in their foreheads.*

5 *And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever.*

“Eternal Life: Trust in the Living God, not in Riches”

1 Timothy 6:17-19

King James Version

17 *Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy;*

18 *That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate;*

19 *Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.*

A Glimpse into Heaven

Revelation 21:21-25

King James Version

21 *And the twelve gates were twelve pearls: every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass.*

22 *And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.*

23 *And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.*

24 *And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.*

25 *And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there.*

“A New Heaven and a New Earth”

Revelation 21

21 *And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.*

2 *And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.*

Hell is the exact opposite. It is a life lived completely alone, separated from God, separated from other people, in the complete dark, no rest, burning in a lake of fire, forever. It is infinitely worse than you could ever imagine and it lasts forever with no possibility of ever returning.

“A Furnace of Fire”
Matthew 13:41-42

- 41** *The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity;*
42 *And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.*

- 28** *And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.*

“Unquenchable Fire”
Matthew 3:12

- 12** *Whose fan is in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.*

“Outer Darkness”
(This isn't a darkness like space where you see stars and planets- this is complete darkness where you can't see anything!)

Matthew 8:12
King James Version

- 12** *But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.*

*kingdom in this context is referring to Satan's kingdom.

“No Rest Day or Night”
(Ever again!)

(Everyone who rejects the gift of eternal salvation through Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and everyone who takes the mark of the beast in the Tribulation)

Revelation 14:11
King James Version

- 11** *And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.*

“Cast Alive into a Lake of Fire burning with Brimstone”

Revelation 19:20

King James Version

20 *And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.*

“And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.”

Revelation 20:11-15 KJV

1 *And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.*

12 *And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.*

13 *And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.*

14 *And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.*

15 *And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.*

*The Book of Life is also known as the Lamb's Book of Life. "The Lamb" is referring to Jesus Christ.

“Everlasting Punishment”

Matthew 25:46

46 *And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.*

(The righteous are those who placed their faith in the righteousness of Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior on their behalf.)

“Fear of the Lord is the Beginning of Wisdom”

Proverbs 9:10

King James Version

10 *The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.*

Why would anyone choose to believe in such a horrible place/eternal existence as Hell?!

This is one of Satan's greatest deceptions that he tries to convince people of- that *they* choose whether there is a Heaven or Hell or what happens after they die, and what that experience is like.

The reality is people don't choose what Heaven is and what Hell is and if there is a Heaven or Hell. There is a Heaven and a Hell and nobody changes either place. You can store up rewards in Heaven through your actions in this life as a believer, but people choose which eternal existence they want at the end of their lives by choosing to believe in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior or reject Him and His gift of eternal salvation. It's that simple.

What happens to those who died believing in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior?

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

King James Version

13 *But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.*

14 *For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.*

15 *For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.*

16 *For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:*

17 *Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.*

18 *Wherefore comfort one another with these words.*

This is why you shouldn't have sorrow for those who have died believing on Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior (are asleep in Christ, in this context, in verses 13-14 above) because they are in Heaven!

Those of us alive when the Lord descends from Heaven to call us up to meet Him in the clouds are going to meet the Lord with them! This is called the "Rapture" or in greek "Harpazo" defined as snatching away or caught up- we are literally going to be snatched away, caught up into Heaven by the Lord! We know this is going to happen very soon according to Bible prophecy.

What happens when you choose to believe in Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior according to the Gospel of Christ in 1 Corinthians 15:1-4?

You are immediately sealed with the Holy Spirit of God until your day of redemption, the day you are called into Heaven with the Lord. You are literally sealed with the presence of God within you, the Holy Spirit of the Trinity: God the Father, Jesus Christ the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

Sealed with the Holy Spirit
Ephesians 1:13-14

- 13** *In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,*
- 14** *Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.*

What is the Holy Spirit?

John 14:26
King James Version

- 26** *But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost (Spirit), whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.*

Matthew 28:19
King James Version

- 19** *Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost(Spirit):*

*The Holy Spirit is one of the 3 members of the Divine Trinity of God. God is the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost (Spirit). He is all three in one. When you receive the Holy Spirit, you are sealed with the Holy Spirit of God within you.

Mysteries Revealed through the Holy Spirit

1 Corinthians 2:7-16
King James Version

- 7** *But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:*
- 8** *Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.*
- 9** *But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.*
- 10** *But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.*

What does it mean to be baptized?

*Baptism means conversion, in this context you are converting to Christ by believing on Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, placing your faith and trust in the Gospel of Christ. Jesus Christ is of the Holy Trinity: God the Father, Jesus Christ the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

How do you become baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit?

You are automatically baptized (sealed) with the Holy Spirit in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit the moment you believe in, trust upon, have faith in Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior based on the Gospel of Christ: 1 Corinthians 15:1-4.

You believe, trust, have faith, receive that:

1. Jesus Christ died on the Cross as a blood atonement for your sins.
2. He was buried.
3. After 3 days He was risen into Heaven.

Sealed with the Holy Spirit

Ephesians 1:13-14

King James Version

13 *In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,*

14 *Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.*

Are you saved? Believe, Receive, Trust, have Faith in the Gospel of Christ *in this very moment* and you are *eternally sealed with His Holy Spirit* until you are either called up to Heaven alive in the Rapture or when you die!

1 Corinthians 15:1-4
King James Version

15 *Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;*

2 *By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.*

3 *For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;*

4 *And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:*

**Share this simple message of eternal salvation through the Gospel (Good News) of Christ with others, it is The Great Commission!*

Matthew 28:18-20

18 *And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.*

19 *Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:*

20 *Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.*

What is the only unforgivable sin?

The only unforgivable sin is blaspheming or rejecting the Holy Spirit. Genuinely rejecting the Holy Spirit, rejecting the blood atonement of Jesus Christ for your sins. Rejecting His gift of eternal salvation.

I believe every person has until the last moment of their life to call upon God and believe in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior, believe by faith alone, that He died for them as a blood atonement for their sins, and still be saved. The only problem with waiting, is nobody knows when they are going to die, and they are missing out on having that permanent security of eternal salvation through Jesus Christ, along with His present and eternal guidance and friendship.

Matthew 12:31-32 KJV

31 *Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men.*

32 *And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come.*

What happens next?

The Rapture of the Church!

You can look forward to and remind others of the hope of the Rapture of the Church! (All believers of Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior for their eternal salvation) into Heaven and the sense of urgency for getting saved *before* the Rapture to escape the 7 Year Tribulation.

16 *For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:*

17 *Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.*

* “Sleep” refers to the dead in this context. Those who have died believing, trusting on Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior, are going straight to heaven the moment they die! (2 [Corinthians 5:8 KJV](#)) Their bodies will be raptured into Heaven, and those of us alive, who have trusted on Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior, are following them in the Rapture of the Church.

“In the Twinkling of an Eye”

1 Corinthians 15:52

King James Version

52 *In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.*

“Keep Looking Up!”

Luke 21:28

“Like Lightning from the East to the West”

Matthew 24:27

King James Version

27 *For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.*

THE 7 YEAR TRIBULATION

The 7-Year Tribulation- the last 7 years before the return of Jesus Christ occurs *after* the Rapture of the Church.

The 7 Year Tribulation officially begins when the Antichrist confirms a peace covenant between Israel and other nations.

We know that Jesus Christ will return to the Mt. Of Olives 7 years *after* the Antichrist confirms the peace covenant.

***Daniel 9:24-27** gives us the timing of the last 7 years before Jesus Christ returns to the Mt. of Olives for the Battle of Armageddon. This is known as the *70th week*. A week in this context is 7 years. While 69 of the 70 weeks of this prophecy in the Book of Daniel 9 written over 2500 years ago has already been fulfilled, we are still waiting on that last, final week- the 7 Year Tribulation, which we are very close to.

Before that 70th week begins, the Rapture of the Church will take place. Christians, everyone who received Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior and believed, trusted, had faith in His blood atonement for their sins on the Cross, will not be here for the 7 Year Tribulation.

Daniel 9:24-27

King James Version

24 *Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.*

25 *Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.*

26 *And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.*

27 *And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.*

*"Anoint the most Holy" in verse 24, of Daniel 9 is referring to the return of Jesus Christ at the end of that 70th week. We know Jesus Christ will return as King over the entire world and reign for 1000 years at the end of the 7 Year Tribulation. These verses give us the exact timing of what to expect over the 7 Year Tribulation.

What is the 7-Year Tribulation?

This is a time-span of 7-years that happens *after* the Rapture of the Church, where the Antichrist will be revealed when he confirms a peace covenant between Israel and other countries. The Antichrist, "the man of sin," "the son of perdition," will exalt himself as being above God. He will eventually sit in the 3rd Temple in Jerusalem, 3 1/2 years after he confirms the peace covenant, showing himself as God:

2 Thessalonians 2:3-12

King James Version

- 3** *Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;*
- 4** *Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.*
- 5** *Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things?*
- 6** *And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time.*
- 7** *For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way.*
- 8** *And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:*
- 9** *Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders,*
- 10** *And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.*
- 11** *And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie:*
- 12** *That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.*

*"That day" in verse 3 is referring to the Day of the Lord, Jesus Christ's return to the Mt. of Olives.

*Jesus Christ will not return until 3 1/2 years *after* the Antichrist sits at the 3rd Temple in Jerusalem claiming to be God. (Daniel 9:24-27 and 2 Thessalonians 2:2:3-12)

When will the Antichrist sit at the 3rd Temple in Jerusalem and declare himself as God?

3 1/2 years *after* he confirms the 7 year peace covenant between Israel and surrounding countries. The Rapture will have already happened. All Christians will have already disappeared from the Earth!

Daniel 9:27
King James Version

27 *And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.*

*One week in this context is 7 years.

-Three and a half years after he confirms this peace covenant, he will stop the animal sacrifices at the Temple- this is known as the "Abomination of Desolation."**(See Daniel 9:27)**

The Jews and everyone else are warned as soon as they see him do this to flee to the mountains, where God will provide them with a supernatural means of escape and provide for them until Jesus Christ returns 3 1/2 years later to the Mt. Of Olives at "Armageddon."

Flee to the Mountains!
Matthew 24:15-16
King James Version

15 *When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)*

16 *Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:*

Revelation 12:6
King James Version

6 *And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.*

*"The woman" in this context is Israel, the Jews. God has prepared a place in the mountains for the Jews to flee to and will provide for them during that last 3 1/2 years of the 7 Year Tribulation.

* There will be a flood and the Jews will be chased, but God will cause an earthquake to swallow the flood and protect the Jews in their escape to the mountains.**(Revelation 12:13-17)**

The Antichrist's Mortal Head Wound Healed
Revelation 13:3-4
King James Version

3 *And I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed: and all the world wondered after the beast.*

4 *And they worshipped the dragon which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who is like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him?*

*People will be amazed and tricked into believing in the Antichrist when they see him miraculously recover from a mortal head wound.

Antichrist's Reign for 3 1/2 Years
Revelation 13:5-8
King James Version

5 And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty and two months.

6 And he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme his name, and his tabernacle, and them that dwell in heaven.

7 And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.

8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

*The Antichrist will briefly have power over the whole world for the last 3 1/2 years of the Tribulation, also known as the Great Tribulation, before Jesus Christ returns at the Battle of Armageddon.

"The book of life of the Lamb slain" in verse 8 is referring to The Lamb's Book of Life, also known as the Book of Life; all those who receive Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior are written into the Lamb's Book of Life. All of those who reject Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior are not written into the Book of Life. Everyone not written into the Book of Life goes to the Great White Throne Judgment after Jesus Christ's 1000 year Millennium Reign, where they will all be condemned to the Lake of Fire forever. **(See Revelation 20:11-15).

The Mark of the Beast

The Antichrist, along with the False Prophet, will demand everyone alive take the "Mark of the Beast," which is the number of his name, 666, on their right hand or forehead. Nobody will be able to buy or sell anything without that mark.

**"his name" verse 17 of Rev. 13 below and "the number of a man" verse 18 of Rev 13, refers to the Antichrist.

The Mark of the Beast
Revelation 13:16-18
King James Version

16 And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads:

17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

18 Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is Six hundred threescore and six.

Warning Against Taking the Mark of the Beast in the Tribulation

Anyone who takes that mark, which is also a sign of worship of the beast, the Antichrist, will automatically condemn themselves to the lake of fire for eternity.

The False Prophet
Revelation 13:11-16

11 *And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon.*

12 *And he exerciseth all the power of the first beast before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed.*

13 *And he doeth great wonders, so that he maketh fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men,*

14 *And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.*

15 *And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.*

16 *And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads:*

*The False Prophet is another man who will help lead others to worship the Antichrist and cause everyone to receive the Mark of the Beast on their right hand, or in their foreheads. Anyone who takes this Mark of the Beast will automatically condemn themselves to the lake of fire for eternity.

Don't Take the Mark of the Beast!
Revelation 14:9-11
King James Version

9 *And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand,*

10 *The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:*

11 *And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.*

The Tribulation:

If you are stuck in the Tribulation (which means you rejected Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior before the Rapture, and that you are lucky enough to still be alive to make the choice):

1. Receive Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior. Believe and trust in the Gospel of Christ: **1 Corinthians 15:1-4**, that Jesus Christ died as a blood atonement for the forgiveness of your sins and that He was buried and risen on the 3rd day into Heaven.
2. Reject the Mark of the Beast. **Revelation 13:16-18 KJV**, **Revelation 14:9-11 KJV**
3. Keep His Commandments. **(Revelation 14:12 KJV)** **(Revelation 12:17 KJV)**
4. Endure to End. **(Matthew 24:13-16 KJV)** **(Revelation 12:11 KJV)**

*You won't be able to buy or sell anything when you reject the mark of the beast, and will most likely suffer persecution and beheading, but you will still have the promise of eternal salvation

through believing, trusting, receiving Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, and rejecting the mark of the beast. You must also endure to the end and keep God's commandments in the Tribulation.

Revelation 20:4
King James Version

4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

Two Witnesses, the 144,000 and Angels

*There will be two bible prophets known as the Two Witnesses most believed to be Moses and Elijah who will return to Jerusalem to warn everyone against taking the Mark of the Beast and helping convert them through the Gospel of Christ. They will eventually be killed by the Antichrist, but will be resurrected by God into Heaven in front of everyone. **(See Revelation 11:1-13).**

*There will be 144,000 Sealed Jewish Witnesses protected by God, warning everyone against taking the mark of the beast and helping convert them through the Gospel of Christ to faith in Jesus Christ. **(See Revelation 14:1-5).**

*There will be Angels flying around warning everyone against taking the mark of the beast and spreading the Gospel of Christ! **(See Revelation 14:6-12).**

The 7 Bowls of God's Wrath: The Great Tribulation-The Final 3 1/2 Years

2/3 of the World Population will Die in the 7 Year Tribulation
Zechariah 13:8
King James Version

8 And it shall come to pass, that in all the land, saith the Lord, two parts therein shall be cut off and die; but the third shall be left therein.

See **Revelation 16.**

What is worse, many will suffer eternal death, eternal damnation to the lake of fire for taking the mark of the beast and rejecting Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior in the Tribulation. If you die without having believed in, receiving His gift of eternal salvation, trusting on Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, you are condemned to the lake of fire for eternity. Everyone who takes the Mark of the Beast is automatically condemned to the lake of fire for eternity.

The Return of Jesus Christ as King

Jesus Christ will return to the Mt. Of Olives 3 1/2 years *after* the Antichrist commits the Abomination of Desolation at the 3rd Temple in Jerusalem. We know this from Daniel 9:24-27 and Revelation 13:5.

30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

The Return of Jesus Christ

The Battle of Armageddon:

Jesus Christ Returns with the Church at the End of the 7 Year Tribulation
Revelation 19:11-21

11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.

14 And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

16 And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, King Of Kings, And Lord Of Lords.

17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;

18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

19 *And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.*

20 *And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.*

21 *And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.*

*A 200 Million man army will be assembled against God at the Battle of Armageddon.

(Revelation 9:16 KJV)

*The Antichrist and False Prophet will be thrown alive into the Lake of Fire. **(Revelation 19:20)**

*Why is it frequently referred to as the "Battle of Armageddon?" Because Jesus Christ will return and wipe out all the armies assembled against Him in an instant at the Valley of Megiddo, also known as the Jezreel Valley. **(Revelation 16:16 KJV)**

*Napoleon was even said to have remarked that this was "the most natural battleground of the whole earth."

*Christians will return with Jesus Christ and have front row seats in the sky, watching this take place! Christians will not fight at the battle- the Lord will wipe out the entire army against Him in an instant!

The Day of the Lord's Return

Zechariah 14

King James Version

14 *Behold, the day of the Lord cometh, and thy spoil shall be divided in the midst of thee.*

2 *For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city.*

3 *Then shall the Lord go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle.*

4 *And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.*

5 *And ye shall flee to the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yea, ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and the Lord my God shall come, and all the saints with thee.*

6 *And it shall come to pass in that day, that the light shall not be clear, nor dark:*

7 *But it shall be one day which shall be known to the Lord, not day, nor night: but it shall come to pass, that at evening time it shall be light.*

8 *And it shall be in that day, that living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea, and half of them toward the hinder sea: in summer and in winter shall it be.*

- 9** *And the Lord shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one Lord, and his name one.*
- 10** *All the land shall be turned as a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, from Benjamin's gate unto the place of the first gate, unto the corner gate, and from the tower of Hananeel unto the king's winepresses.*
- 11** *And men shall dwell in it, and there shall be no more utter destruction; but Jerusalem shall be safely inhabited.*
- 12** *And this shall be the plague wherewith the Lord will smite all the people that have fought against Jerusalem; Their flesh shall consume away while they stand upon their feet, and their eyes shall consume away in their holes, and their tongue shall consume away in their mouth.*
- 13** *And it shall come to pass in that day, that a great tumult from the Lord shall be among them; and they shall lay hold every one on the hand of his neighbour, and his hand shall rise up against the hand of his neighbour.*
- 14** *And Judah also shall fight at Jerusalem; and the wealth of all the heathen round about shall be gathered together, gold, and silver, and apparel, in great abundance.*
- 15** *And so shall be the plague of the horse, of the mule, of the camel, and of the ass, and of all the beasts that shall be in these tents, as this plague.*
- 16** *And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles.*
- 17** *And it shall be, that whoso will not come up of all the families of the earth unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain.*
- 18** *And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that have no rain; there shall be the plague, wherewith the Lord will smite the heathen that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.*
- 19** *This shall be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all nations that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.*
- 20** *In that day shall there be upon the bells of the horses, Holiness Unto The Lord; and the pots in the Lord's house shall be like the bowls before the altar.*
- 21** *Yea, every pot in Jerusalem and in Judah shall be holiness unto the Lord of hosts: and all they that sacrifice shall come and take of them, and seethe therein: and in that day there shall be no more the Canaanite in the house of the Lord of hosts.*

After the Battle of Armageddon, (Which is over in an instant) the Lord will separate the remaining believers who survived, from the unbelievers. This is known as separating the sheep from the goats.

Jesus Divides the Sheep from the Goats

Matthew 25:31-46
King James Version

- 31** *When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory:*
- 32** *And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats:*
- 33** *And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left.*

34 Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

35 For I was an hungred, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in:

36 Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me.

37 Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, and fed thee? or thirsty, and gave thee drink?

38 When saw we thee a stranger, and took thee in? or naked, and clothed thee?

39 Or when saw we thee sick, or in prison, and came unto thee?

40 And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.

41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

42 For I was an hungred, and ye gave me no meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me no drink:

43 I was a stranger, and ye took me not in: naked, and ye clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and ye visited me not.

44 Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, or athirst, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister unto thee?

45 Then shall he answer them, saying, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye did it not to one of the least of these, ye did it not to me.

46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.

*Those who rejected Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior and took the mark of the beast, represented as the goats, will be condemned to everlasting punishment in the lake of fire.

Jesus Christ will reign as King in Jerusalem for 1000 Years- The Millennium. (Rev 20:4)
Satan will be imprisoned in chains during that 1000 years. (Revelation 20:1-3)

Revelation 20:4

At the end of the 1000 Year (Millennium) Reign of Jesus Christ:

- Satan will be briefly loosed one last time, then cast into the Lake of Fire (Rev 20:7-10)
- The Great White Throne Judgment will take place- all non-believers will be judged and condemned to the Lake of Fire for Eternity. (Rev 20:11-15)
- All Believers, who believed in the Gospel of Christ, received Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior, will continue on their journey with the Lord into Eternity with Him in His Kingdom/Paradise!
- A New Heaven and A New Earth! (Revelation 21-22)

Receive/Believe in the Gospel (Good News) of Jesus Christ Today!

Escape the 7 Year Tribulation!

Watch Sermons on TV, or You Tube.

Bible Apps for your Phone.

Share the Gospel of Christ with Others- We're getting close to the Rapture of the Church and there are many people who are unsaved!

Do Good Works!

Help People.

Donate a percentage of your time and income to charities and good causes you trust, believe in, and want to help.

Not because you're trying to earn your way into Heaven- if you received Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior and placed your faith/trust on His word, His blood atonement on the Cross for your sins, you are already saved-sealed until you get to Heaven! You are in His family- you are now an Ambassador for Christ!
