

End Times Instructions Before Jesus Christ Returns



Matthew 24:15-16 KJV

15 *When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)* **16** *Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:*

Tribulation Warnings For the Jews & Everyone Else Get Saved Now! Escape the Tribulation

It's amazing how God prophesies everything ahead of time through His Word, His prophets in the Bible!

Let's address the arrival of the Antichrist first in the Tribulation, because many people will be fooled, including the Jews.

The Jews are still waiting for the arrival of their Messiah. Jesus Christ Himself prophesied they would not receive Him, but another, who would come in his own name:

John 5:43 KJV

***43** I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive.*

The Jews, along with everyone else living before the Rapture of the Church, still have the opportunity right now to get saved and receive Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior by grace through faith alone, that He died as a blood atonement for their sins, was buried, and rose again on the 3rd day into Heaven according to the scriptures. (See **1 Corinthians 15:1-4** The Gospel of Salvation and **Ephesians 2:8-9**)

All Jews (or anyone else) who chooses right now (before the Rapture) to believe in the blood of Christ for their eternal salvation will be saved and *escape* the Tribulation- they will go up in the Rapture of the Church!

After the Rapture/ The 7 Year Tribulation

All who are left behind (and survive) in the Tribulation, because they chose not to believe, will witness the Antichrist, who is the one who comes in his own name as God- the one Jesus prophesied 2,000 years ago in **(John 5:43)** that they would believe he is the true Messiah.

The Apostle Paul confirms this prophesy in his 2nd Epistle to the Thessalonians **2 Thessalonians 2**, which he wrote nearly 2,000 years ago!

2 Thessalonians 2 KJV

- 1** Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him,
- 2** That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.
- 3** Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;
- 4** Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.
- 5** Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things?
- 6** And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time.
- 7** For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way.
- 8** And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:
- 9** Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders,
- 10** And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.
- 11** And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie:
- 12** That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.
- 13** But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:
- 14** Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 15** Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle.
- 16** Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace,
- 17** Comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work.

Jesus Christ, the true God, Messiah, will not return until *after* the Antichrist comes first. The Antichrist will claim to be God at the 3rd Temple in Jerusalem.

The Antichrist will come first, proclaiming himself to be God at the 3rd Temple, 3 1/2 years after he confirms the peace covenant between Israel and other countries.

The true God, Jesus Christ, Messiah, will return 3 1/2 years *after* the Antichrist desecrates the 3rd Temple.

The Day of the Lord in the scriptures, refers to the returning of Jesus Christ as King at the end of the 7 year Tribulation. What marks the beginning of the 7 year Tribulation? When the Antichrist confirms the 7 year peace covenant between Israel and other countries.

Daniel 9:27 KJV

***27** And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.*

We know through 2 Thessalonians 2 that the Antichrist will not be made known until *after* the Rapture- after the Holy Spirit, “He” (verse 7) is taken out of the way. This refers to the Rapture of the Church.

The Rapture of the Church is the event that will happen very soon where Jesus Christ will catch all Christians up into the clouds to meet Him into Heaven and escape the Tribulation! We are to encourage each other with these words!

1 Thessalonians 4:16-18 KJV

***16** For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. **17** After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever. **18** Therefore encourage one another with these words.*

The Jews and everyone left behind who survive in the Tribulation [(2/3 of the earth's population will be destroyed from wars, famine, etc. ([Zechariah 13:8-9](#)))] will witness the Antichrist confirm the false peace covenant with Israel.

As soon as that happens, you know it will be exactly 7 years from that date that Jesus Christ will return to the Mount of Olives. ([Zechariah 14](#)) Jesus Christ will return exactly 3 1/2 years *after* the Antichrist desecrates the 3rd Temple, claiming to be God at the 3rd Temple, because it says in [Daniel 9:27](#) that the Antichrist will desecrate the Temple in the middle of that week (3 1/2 years into the 7 year Tribulation.)

2/3 of the Earth's remaining population will be destroyed in the Tribulation.

Zechariah 13:8-9 KJV

8 And it shall come to pass that in all the land," saith the Lord, "two parts therein shall be cut off and die, but the third shall be left therein.

9 And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried. They shall call on My name, and I will hear them. I will say, 'It is My people'; and they shall say, 'The Lord is my God.'"

Salvation During the 7 Year Tribulation

The Gospel of the Kingdom: (Faith and Works) **(Matt 24:13-16)**

*The Gospel of the Kingdom will be preached to the whole world during the Tribulation by the 144,000 Sealed Jewish witnesses representing the 12 Tribes of Israel, and Two Witnesses (Most likely Old Testament Prophets, Moses and Elijah) proclaiming the Good News of the soon return of Jesus Christ as Messiah/King at the end of that 7 Year Tribulation, encouraging everyone to have faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, Endure to the End, Keep His Commandments, and Deny the Mark of the Beast of the Antichrist.

-Endure to the end when Jesus Christ returns. **(Matthew 24:13)**

-Faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and keeping His Commandments (Jews)

(Rev 12:17)

-Faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and keeping His commandments.(Tribulation Saints)

(Rev 14:12)

-Do His Commandments **(Revelation 22:14)**

-Those in Judea should flee to the mountains as soon as they see the Antichrist desecrate the 3rd Temple. **(Matthew 24:15-18)**

-Willing to become a Martyr for testimony of Jesus Christ. **Revelation 12:11** and

Revelation 20:4

-Reject the Mark of the Beast **(Rev 14:9-11)**

Matthew 24:13-16 KJV

13 But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

15 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)

16 Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:

Revelation 12:17 KJV

17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

Revelation 12:11 KJV

11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

Revelation 20:4 KJV

4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

Deny the Mark of the Beast

The Antichrist is going to proclaim himself as God at the 3rd Temple in Jerusalem and command everyone take his mark in order to buy or sell:

Revelation 13:16-18 KJV

16 And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads:

17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

18 Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is Six hundred threescore and six.

What happens to anyone who takes the mark of the beast?

Anyone who takes the mark of the beast on their right hand or forehead will go to the lake of fire for eternity. ([Reference Revelation 14:9-11 KJV](#))

Revelation 14:9-11 KJV

9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand,

10 The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

11 And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.

The 144,000 Sealed Jewish Witnesses
Revelation 7:4-17 KJV

4 *And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.*

5 *Of the tribe of Juda were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Reuben were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Gad were sealed twelve thousand.*

6 *Of the tribe of Aser were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Nephthalim were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Manasses were sealed twelve thousand.*

7 *Of the tribe of Simeon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Levi were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Issachar were sealed twelve thousand.*

8 *Of the tribe of Zabulon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Joseph were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Benjamin were sealed twelve thousand.*

9 *After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;*

10 *And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.*

11 *And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God,*

12 *Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen.*

13 *And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they?*

14 *And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.*

15 *Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.*

16 *They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat.*

17 *For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes.*

Many will be saved during the Tribulation

Revelation 7:9 KJV

9 *After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;*

There will be 2 Witnesses- Prophets from the Old Testament in Jerusalem- most likely Moses and Elijah (They will prophesy and warn everyone for 3 1/2 years)

Revelation 11:3-13 KJV

3 *And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.*

4 *These are the two olive trees, and the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth.*

5 *And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.*

6 *These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.*

7 *And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.*

8 *And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.*

9 *And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies three days and an half, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.*

10 *And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.*

11 *And after three days and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.*

12 *And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them.*

13 *And the same hour was there a great earthquake, and the tenth part of the city fell, and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven.*

What can unsaved, non-believers do now (before the Rapture of the Church) to be saved?

If you are an unsaved Jew or anyone else, you don't believe or haven't put your trust in the gospel of salvation, **1 Corinthians 15:1-4** the blood atonement of Jesus Christ for your sins, you have this opportunity right now to get saved and skip the Tribulation!

All you need to do to be saved before the Rapture of the Church is believe, trust, place your faith in the Gospel (Good News) of Salvation: Jesus Christ died as a blood atonement for your sins, was buried, and rose again on the 3rd day into Heaven. The moment you believe, you are sealed with God's Holy Spirit until the day of your redemption into Heaven. (**1 Corinthians 15:1-4 KJV, Ephesians 1:13-14 KJV.**)

For the Jews

God has set aside the 7 Year Tribulation specifically to return to you. It is a time known as Jacob's Trouble. The Antichrist will deceive Israel at first confirming the false peace covenant *after* the Rapture of the Church.

Matthew 24:15-16 KJV

15 *When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)*

16 *Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:*

God is going to provide for the Jews who flee to the mountains until He returns 3 1/2 years later to the Mount of Olives. Jews should have faith in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior-believing the Gospel of their Salvation **1 Corinthians 15:1-4**, keep God's Commandments, endure to the end, *and* reject the mark of the beast until Jesus Christ returns.

Revelation 12:6 KJV

6 *And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.*

*The woman referred to here is the remnant of Israel, the Jews. They will be provided for in the mountains, most likely Petra, for the remaining 3 1/2 years until Jesus Christ returns.
